## **About Vikram Dev University**

Vikram Dev University is a new university upgraded by Govt. of Odisha in 2023. Prior to that, the institution was one of the premier Educational institutions of Odisha which was affiliated to Berhampur University and was recognized by the UGC under rule-128 (1956) of UGC Act. Indeed, it is an educational hub for the students of undivided Koraput districts of Odisha which was established before independence (i.e. 1st July, 1947). Moreover, now it is the only university of undivided Koraput districts of Odisha. The university provides UG and PG courses across the disciplines and in the coming academic year 2023-24, the Ph.D Programme will be started.

The two years B.Ed. Programme under self-financing mode was opened from the Academic Session 2018-19 Vide NCTE Approval F. No.ER.6.35 (Part-2)/APP 11012/BEd/2018/56240, dated. 02.03.2018 and Govt. of Odisha, Higher Education Department Letter No. 11315/HE, dt. 27.05.2015 and Berhampur University Letter No. 5237, dt. 29.05.2015. Again the NCTE restored the Two Years B.Ed. Programme in the University Vide the Order No. F. No. ER-333.4/NCTE/ERCAPP201646242/6895, dt. 19/10/2023.

## **Concept Note**

Koraput is one of the tribal dominated socio-economically backward districts of Odisha. The district represents more than 50% of Scheduled Tribe population. The district is a famous for its scenic beauty, rich cultural heritage and simplicity of inhabitants of Koraput. Educationally, the district is comparatively backward than other districts of Odisha. The dropout rates at all levels of education are also relatively higher than state and national norm. But due to the enormous efforts of Govt. of Odisha and India, the enrolment, retention and achievements levels of students in the district are increasing day by day.
